

# **PUSH-BACK INTERCOM**

U9920-GPB

**PURGING INSTRUCTIONS** 





First, <u>turn off</u> the Belt Station power by <u>pressing the power button</u> on the side of the unit







Next, <u>push</u> and <u>hold</u> the <u>PTT</u> <u>switch</u> on the front of the unit.



**PTT BUTTON** 





Then, <u>push</u> and <u>hold</u> the <u>power</u> <u>button</u>, powering the unit up, **while continuing to hold the PTT switch** 







To complete the process, **when the LED indicator turns** <u>red</u>, <u>release the power button...</u>



...then <u>release the PTT switch</u>. The LED indicator will <u>flash red</u> For 15 to 20 seconds, followed by a voice prompt, "Connection Deleted."





The Push-Back Gateway also allows for a 'full purge'.

A full purge is a quick method of purging all linked Belt Stations at one time.





To execute a full purge, first <u>turn off the Gateway</u> — if not already off - by <u>pressing the power button on the face of the unit</u>.







Next, <u>push</u> and <u>hold</u> the <u>PTT</u> switch on the face of the unit.







Then, <u>push</u> and <u>hold</u> the <u>power button</u> until the power is on, indicated by the LED showing as solid red, <u>while</u> <u>continuing to hold the PTT switch.</u>







Next, <u>release the power button</u>, <u>while continuing to hold the PTT switch.</u>







Finally, <u>release the PTT button</u>.





All previously linked Belt Stations are now purged and ready to link again, when needed, to any 9900 Series Gateway.
