Features


- Heavy gauge steel construction for long-term durability

- Won't interfere with levers or factory-installed consoles located on transmission hump
- Won't interfere with passenger leg space

Seat bolts in the 2005-2006 Dodge Dakota vehicles are tied into the air bag sensor system. Loosening or removal of seat bolts in the 2005-2006 vehicles will require recalibration by a certified Daimlyer-Chrysler service technician.
