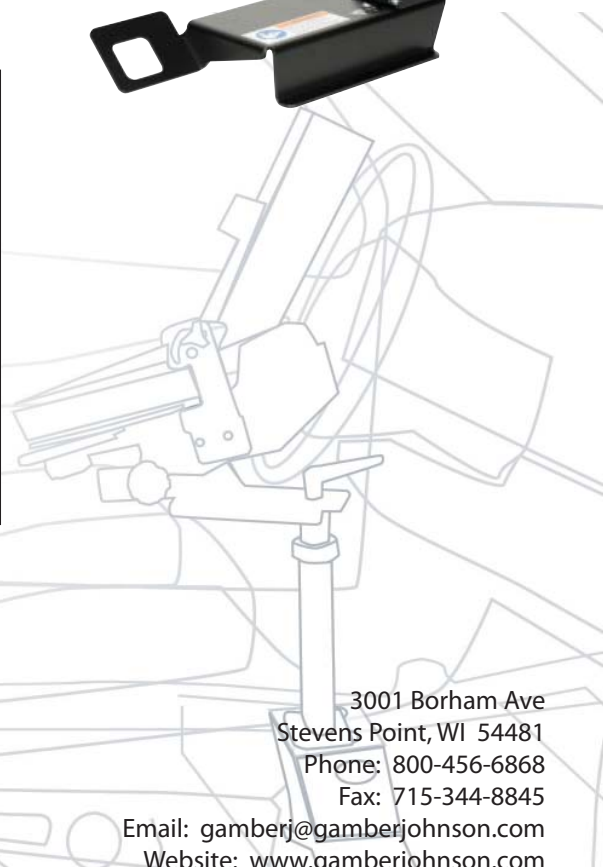
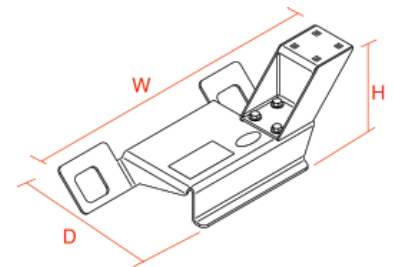

Features

- Heavy gauge steel construction for long-term durability
- Black powdercoat finish for maximum corrosion resistance
- Angled step moves pole away from passenger leg space
- Will not interfere with levers or factory installed consoles
- One *Offset Universal Mounting Step* (Item No. DS-STEP) is already included with this vehicle base. However, additional *Offset Universal Mounting Steps* can be ordered to stack on top of each other if needed.
- A *Support Brace* (Item No. LAC-03) is highly recommended. An existing bolt (heater box mounting bolt) in the vehicle can be used as an attachment point for the support brace.
