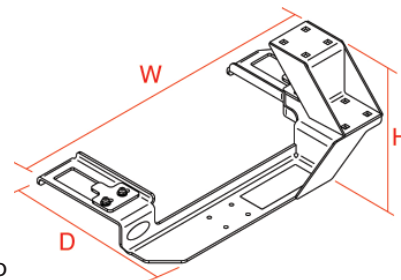

Features

- Heavy gauge steel construction for long-term durability
- Black powdercoat finish for maximum corrosion resistance
- The base uses the weight and pressure of the seat and the mechanical counter balance of the base design to secure it under the seat. **Due to not being secured using the seat bolts, we strongly recommend you fasten the base by using the four holes located on the base and drill into the floor.**
- One *Offset Universal Mounting Step* (Item No. DS-STEP) is already included with this vehicle base. However, additional *Offset Universal Mounting Steps* can be ordered to stack on top of each other if needed.
- The *Offset Universal Mounting Step* should be pointed towards the passenger seat to move the mounting system away from the dash
- A *Support Brace* (Item No. LAC-02) is highly recommended to reduce system vibration
